Matrubhumi Sewa Kendra Charitable Trust was established by **Late Shri Chhataram Hindwaniji**, a devoted RSS member with an unwavering passion for community service. Understanding the severe lack of basic amenities in remote tribal regions, he envisioned an organization that would bring education, empowerment, and dignity to the most underprivileged.



A Mission Rooted in Service to the Forgotten

Hindwaniji began his journey not with resources, but with people. He united volunteers and community members to initiate development in villages where no government schemes reached—no electricity, no grants, and no schooling infrastructure. His work marked the beginning of real grassroots change.



Digital Literacy Begins with 'Nilbhavan'

As the Trust's first initiative, Boys chhatralaya with 100 student capacity with computer room named "Nilbhavan" was established in the villages of Virvad and Sidumbar. Also one girls chhatralaya was completed with the help of trust members at Virvad. It was a bold step to introduce digital education in a region where even basic schooling was absent. This move laid the foundation for bridging the digital divide among tribal youth.



Empowering Girls through Pindwal Chhatralaya (2014)

In 2018, the Trust built the Pindwal Chhatralaya, a dedicated residential facility for tribal girls from Grade 9 to 12. Starting with 65 girls, the hostel offered a safe and structured environment to continue secondary education — a rare opportunity for girls in these rural areas.



Vaghwad Chhatralaya – A Step Toward Inclusive Education (2020)

With a growing demand for residential education, the Trust inaugurated the Vaghwad Chhatralaya in 2020, accommodating 90 boys and girls from Grades 3 to 8. This chhatralaya became a symbol of gender-inclusive education, nurturing the potential of younger students from surrounding tribal hamlets.



Expanding Reach through Bopi Chhatralaya (2016)

Also launched in 2016, the Bopi Chhatralaya began as a hostel exclusively for girls (Grades 9 to 12). Housing 90 students, it provided not just lodging, but also mentorship, guidance, and emotional support — factors critical for girl child education in rural settings.



From Hostel to School – Bopi Chhatralaya Upgraded (2022)

In 2022, the Bopi Chhatralaya saw a major transformation — upgraded to include a full-fledged secondary school “Hindwaniji High School” offering education from Grades 9 to 12, now serving 200 boys and girls in school. The upgrade included classrooms, staff, and additional educational resources — allowing students to pursue quality education without leaving their village.



Modern Facilities That Inspire Confidence

The Trust has invested in state-of-the-art infrastructure across its chhatralayas. All campuses now include:

- Computer Labs to build digital literacy
- Smart Boards for interactive teaching
- Well-stocked Libraries to promote reading habits
- Sports Equipment to encourage holistic development

These facilities have not only enhanced learning but also instilled confidence, curiosity, and ambition among the students.



Showcasing Talent Beyond Academics

The Trust also encourages students to participate in extracurricular platforms. For the past three consecutive years, students from Vaghwad and Bopi have proudly participated in the popular cultural event "Valsad's Got Talent", showcasing their creativity and hidden talents.



Enabling Higher Education and Career Opportunities

With continued academic and financial support from the Trust & donors, students are now confidently stepping into professional education:

- 7 girls have secured admissions in BCA (Bachelor of Computer Applications) in 2024-25
- 15 girls have enrolled in reputed Nursing programs
- 5 of these girls have recently begun internships at Lotus Hospital - Valsad, marking a huge achievement for their families and the community.

Future Vision: Expanding Horizons for a Brighter Tomorrow

After the visionary foundation laid by Late Shri Chhataram Hindwaniji, the management of our chhatralay activities has been gracefully carried forward by Shri Rameshbhai Fuletra, who continues to guide us with dedication and foresight.

As of today, over 300 students are benefiting from our educational support across three chhatralays. To accommodate the growing need and to provide better living and learning conditions, we are aiming to expand our hostel facilities across all centers.

- **Doubling Educational Reach:** Our goal is to double the number of students pursuing higher education, especially in BCA and Nursing streams, by providing consistent academic and residential support.
- **New Boys Hostel at Bopi:** Plans are underway to construct a dedicated boys' hostel in Bopi, designed to comfortably accommodate 20 students initially.
- **Smart Learning Facilities:** We have upgrading our infrastructure by introducing laptops, desktop computers, and smart boards in the school, ensuring that students receive modern, interactive, and digital education.

These steps are part of our long-term vision to nurture the next generation of scholars, professionals, and responsible citizens. With the continued support of well-wishers, we are confident in achieving these milestones in the near future.
